

## **Certificate of Ministry (Core Subjects)**

- 1 <u>Intro to Israel's Scriptures</u> a journey of tracing Old Testament biblical themes: creation, covenant, Torah, worship and many others.
- ·2 Into to the New Testament Seeks to introduce the content of the NT with a view to providing a basis for further reading and study.
- ·3 <u>Preaching</u> describes the knowledge and skills necessary for planning and delivering a speech in public, using strategies that will enhance the presentation and maintain audience interest.
- •4 <u>Intro to Pastoral Ministry</u> helps students develop the knowledge and skills required to provide effective pastoral care.
- •5 <u>Christian Worldview</u> looks at the Christian worldview, derived from the Scriptures and Christian tradition.
- •6 <u>Professional Practice in Ministry</u> Two parts A and B. Practical connection of the classroom to real life experience. Hands-on placement of 100 hours whilst serving the Church.

## **Certificate of Ministry (Elective Subjects)**

- 1 <u>Christian Spirituality</u> this unit is an introduction to contemporary Christian approaches to spiritual disciplines and spirituality.
- ·2 <u>Genesis</u> a study of the book of Genesis which is essential for understanding our faith today. The foundational themes of creation, faith, salvation, covenant and patriarchs such as Abraham, Jacob and Joseph are studied.
